RESPONSIBILITIES

EMIM is fortunate to have a supportive and friendly parent body. A collaborative working relationship between parents, faculty and administrators enhances the experiences and education of all children at EMIM. To help better define our respective roles and expectations, and in the spirit of EMIM and our commitment to Global Citizenship.

1 Respect the caring ethos of the School by conducting themselves in a respectful and orderly manner whenever of the School property or when representing the school off-site.

2 Treat all members of the community with respect by using appropriate language and a dignified tone when speaking to others.

3 Support and help your child to observe all school regulations, including protecting the School's equipment, property and good name.

4 If, under exceptional circumstances, you are asked to pick up your child for whatever reason, you do so immediately.

5 Communicate promptly, honestly and openly about your child and utilize the communication channels provided by the school.

6 Schedule to meet teachers or faculty members outside of class hours to avoid disruption of regular classroom activities.

7 Seek to clarify a child's version of events with the School as part of a peaceful resolution process.

8 Correct any child in your care if their actions could lead to conflict, aggressive, or unsafe behaviour.

9 Seek information and raise concerns directly with the school through the appropriate channels.

10 Promptly report your child(ren)'s absence or late arrival.

11 Avoid entering the School and/or remaining on school property without authorization after the school is closed.

12 Respect normally accepted conventions regarding confidentiality.



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
