### **STEM**

Science and Technology classes are not mandatory for Cycle 1 students. For Cycle 2 and 3 students, the Ministry of Education only suggests that we teach the course.

ÉMIM follows the science and technology program but also offers an enriched STEM program which includes: science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. This is available for both daycare and elementary children.

## **Physical Education**

Wow! ÉMIM certainly offers a rich physical education program! We offer two hours of physical education which include various activities, games, and traditional sports. We also offer snowshoeing, swimming, and tennis! The Ministry of Education recommends that we should offer two hours of physical education a week.
